### **SUPER TEACHING AIDS – SUPER PRICE!**



For many years, Auxiliary Public Education instructors have been very creative assembling visual aids that enable students to get their hands on a variety of the equipment and devices we tell them about in our classes. Chock full of all types of PFDs, VDS (all safe and disarmed), miniature ATON examples, boating safety videos, boating safety booklets, and signaling devices, the contents of the kit would cost anyone over \$1,000 for the products included alone and that doesn't include the cost of the travel case. National Safe Boating Council charges only \$650.00 plus shipping for non-members or \$550.00 plus shipping for members. Since it will only cost a Flotilla \$50.00 to join the National Safe Boating Council, your Flotilla could join NSBC and purchase the kit for \$600 plus shipping on the kit...your Flotilla joins NSBC and gets the kit for \$50.00 less than the non-member price. It's a real bargain!
